PRICES

- **General price - EUR 3,950**
- **Early Bird price - EUR 3,600 (for fees paid in full by February 5, 2025)**

*** Rates are per person, based on double occupancy.** For single rooms, an additional **supplemental fee of EUR 600** will apply.

Note: Single rooms are limited. We can assist with pairing up individual travelers in twin rooms.

TOUR PRICE INCLUDES:

- Accommodation in 4-star and superior boutique hotels, including daily breakfast. Please note that listed hotels are subject to change based on availability.
- 8 dinners, including Shabbat dinners (water and wine included at meals, vegetarian options by request, certified kosher is not available).
- Touring in a comfortable, air-conditioned coach bus.
- Entrance fees as specified in the itinerary.
- Experienced, licensed English speaking tour guides.
- An expert guide from **Jerulita Travel** will accompany the group from arrival until departure along with a **Nora Kaplan Learn-in-trips** tour group leader.

PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- International airfare to Lithuania and return flight from Estonia.
- Ground transportation to and from airports on arrival and departure.

includes cancellation for any reason (including COVID19) as **Nora Kaplan Ltd.** cannot be held liable for any mishaps during participants stay.

- Entrance fee to optional attractions during free time.
- Personal extras such as laundry, or beverages and food other than the included in the program's breakfasts and group meals.
- Tips for local service providers (guides, drivers, portage...): EUR 10/person/day to be collected in cash at the beginning of the trip (EUR 100/person).
- Miscellaneous expenses such as departure fees, visas, security surcharges, etc. where applicable.

PAYMENTS:

- A **non-refundable deposit of EUR 500** per person is required at the time of booking to confirm your reservation.
- **The full tour fee before February 5, 2025, is EUR 3,600 (including the EUR 500 non-refundable deposit),** and can be paid at the time of booking.
- **The full tour fee after February 5, 2025, is EUR 3,950 (including the EUR 500 non-refundable deposit),** and can be paid at the time of booking.
- For instalment payments of the Main Tour:
 1. **EUR 2,225** must be paid at the time of booking (including the EUR 500 non-refundable deposit).
 2. **EUR 1,725** must be paid by April 20 (or the EUR 2,200 first payment, if not already paid).
- A single supplement of EUR 600, if applicable, must be paid by April 20.
- Credit card information of the participants will be required when checking in at the hotels as a guarantee in case of hotel incidentals or damage.

***A minimum of 15 participants is required to run the Tour. If the group size is between 12 and 14 participants, an additional EUR 100 will be required by May 5, 2025.**

CANCELLATION FEES

- The deposit of EUR 500 is non-refundable.
- For cancellations made more than 45 days before the start of the main trip, a full refund will be issued, minus the non-refundable deposit.

- If canceled between 45 and 15 days before the start of the tour, a 50% penalty will apply, in addition to the non-refundable deposit.
- For cancelations made less than 15 days before the tour start date, a 100% penalty will apply.
